SAFE Family Ministries is a Christian-centered ministry, involving people working together to restore the lives of women, and women with children. Jesus promised, "If the Son shall set you free, you shall be free, indeed." John 8:36

SAFE Family Ministries provides new life and freedom to women through Jesus Christ by using God's word, compassion, counseling, new life skills, and a lovely place to live.

SAFE Family Ministries' purpose is to bring emotional, physical, mental and spiritual wellness to those who want to make a change from social, sexual, drug, mental and physical abuse.

SAFE Family Ministries will enable women to break free from destructive habits and/or destructive people, to make good decisions, and set realistic goals with a plan to obtain them.

Since July of 2005, individuals and churches have contributed financial support and "sweat equity" for the required repairs to see that SAFE opened in September.

SAFE's first young women were welcomed on September 25, 2005 to their new home in the Hope House. In December 2013, we were granted an occupancy permit for the entire campus. Praise God for answered prayers!

HISTORY AND UPDATE

Forest Manor Retirement Center was a licensed nursing home through the Department of Social & Health Services for 60 clients, until it was closed by the State Fire Marshall and the DSHS. The facility is a two-story masonry structure, constructed in the late 1920's; it has been remodeled over the years. The annex (Hope House) has had multiple uses, most recently to house nursing staff. The campus served as Lewis County's Poor Farm and a tuberculosis center in the 1930's and 1940's. Over the decades, it has served as multiple licensed nursing homes.

On April 28, 2008, SAFE Family Ministries purchased the 16.7 acres, which reduced our monthly operating costs. The monthly operational expenses are about \$12,000 to date; no salaries are paid, as everyone is a volunteer. However, there are large financial expenses, even with the volunteer labor. There is a substantial outlay for program materials and resources needed to provide the Christ-centered, Biblical counseling, which will enable healing and wholeness to women and children.

We thank God for the individuals, churches, businesses and foundations who have given thus far. Talk to the Lord; you too can make a difference.

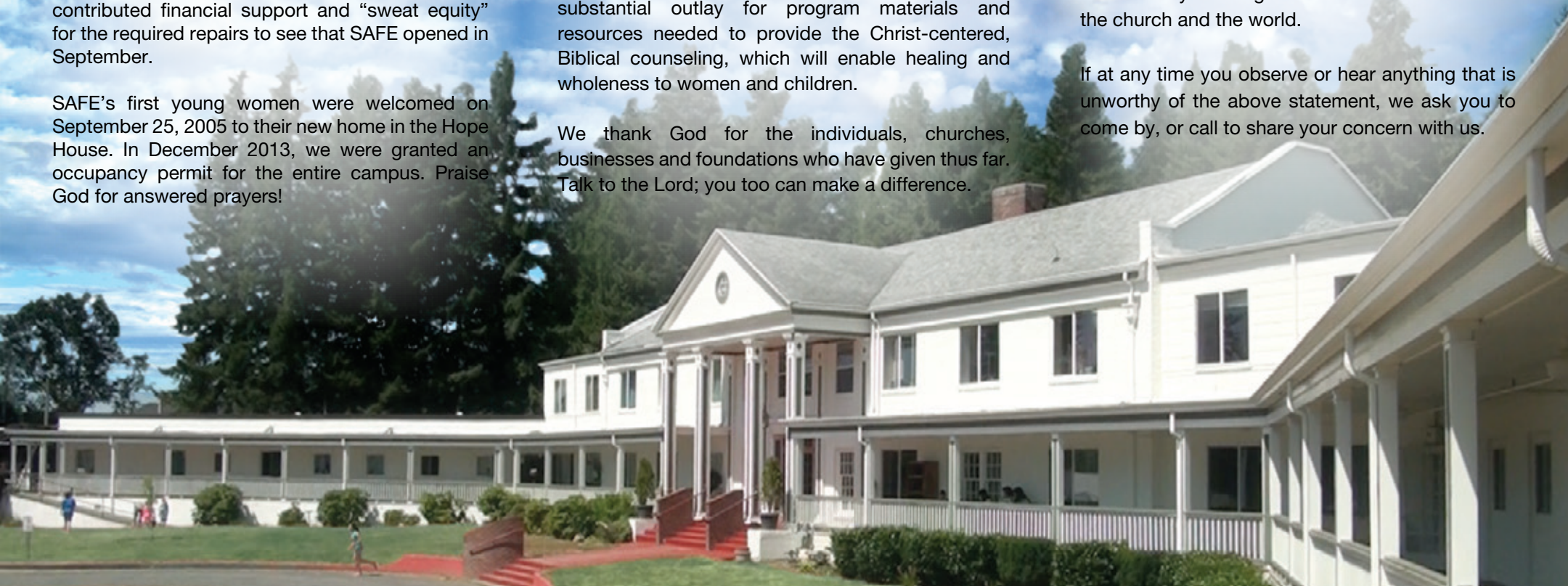
DEAR PASTORS, BUSINESSES, FAMILY AND NEIGHBORS
